Rules and Regulations

Rules

1. The Arizona Summer State HS Basketball Championship tournament will be played according to Arizona High School AIA association rules with the following exceptions.
2. 16 minute running clock per half with the exception of the last two minutes of the 2nd half where the clock will stop on dead ball situations.
3. Overtimes will be 3 minutes in length and each team will be award one additional time out per overtime.
4. All shooting fouls will be 1 shot for two points. All fouls after 7 will be 1 and 1. All technical fouls and intentional fouls will be 2 shots plus possession. All fouls in the last two minutes of the 2nd half and overtime will be shot per regulation AIA rules.
5. Teams will receive 2 time outs per half, with no carry over by half.

Age Requirements

1. Varsity-Must have at least one year of AIA varsity eligibility remaining to participate. No graduated players may participate.
2. JV-No seniors may play in the JV Division.
3. Freshman-No sophomores may play in the Freshman Division.
4. Players may play up and in two divisions if they meet the eligibility requirements listed here.
5. No provision will be made in the bracketing to accommodate teams that play players in two divisions.
6. Each participating team will be required to submit an entry roster by June 21st, 2010 signed by the Head Coach and School's Athletic Director. Violation of any eligibility rules will mean forfeiture of game and exit from the tournament, and a one year ban from the next year's tournament.
7. All questions of eligibility will be handled and at the sole discretion of the Executive Director of the Grand Canyon State Games based upon recommendations of the ABCA Executive Director Art Hall and GCSG Basketball Commissioner.
